



FAMILY BASED MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

Family Based Mental Health Services (FBMH) provides intensive family and individual therapy, delivered in the home and community, to children with a diagnosed mental health condition, who are at risk for out-of-home placement. The service is team delivered by a therapist and case manager who focus on the mental health needs of the child, the relationships within the family system and the natural strengths of the family.

Family Based Services include:

- Initiation of services within 24-hours of acceptance into the program.
- 24-hour availability of supportive services
- Therapeutic interventions to individuals and families during stressful life events and assistance to families as they transition from inpatient hospitalization or from a residential treatment center.
- Comprehensive services from clinical assessment; active treatment; family support; service linkage and referral; case management; relief care, which may include respite; brief babysitting; transportation; homemaker services and therapeutic recreational opportunities.

A BRIDGE TO A BRIGHTER FUTURE

At Glade Run Lutheran Services people are shown a bridge to a brighter future. Our goal is to join with children, adults and families to help them lead a life filled with promise and success.

Our community based programs focus on providing services to people in their own community by offering a broad spectrum of mental health and supportive services in Allegheny, Butler and Beaver counties. All services are provided by highly trained staff who utilize various treatment methods tailored to the clients needs, including structural family therapy and cognitive behavioral therapy.



OUTPATIENT COUNSELING

Outpatient Counseling can help anyone experiencing life problems or mental health issues. Services are available to individuals ages 5 and older and are provided by Master's level clinicians.

Outpatient Counseling may include:

- Individual, family and group therapy for people facing marital or family issues, parent-child relationship problems, separation and loss, sexual abuse, depression, anxiety disorders, bipolar disorders and Attention-Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder.
- Each client participates in creating an individual treatment plan based on goals and objectives.
- On-site psychiatric services are available for evaluation and/or medication management.

WRAPAROUND

Wraparound (BHRS) provides enhanced behavioral health treatment to children up to age 21 who have mental health or Autism Spectrum Disorder treatment needs. This is a child centered service for families who are having difficulty managing a child's behavior. This treatment uses professional staff and natural supports to literally "wrap" services around an identified child and the child's family.

Wraparound services include:

- Services provided in the child's home, community and school.
- Autism and behavioral expertise to help families in creating an individual treatment plan based on their goals and objectives.
- The use of community resources to achieve maximum improvement in the child's function with minimum disruption to the family unit.
- An interagency team which may include mobile therapy, therapeutic staff supports, behavioral specialist, teachers, vocational training counselor, medical and legal advisors.
- Parent education and support.

BLENDED CASE MANAGEMENT

Blended Case Management provides case management to adults with persistent mental illness and children with serious mental illness or emotional disorders. The goal is to maintain the client in their own community.

Blended Case Management includes:

- 24-hour access to case management services
- Assistance in accessing appropriate mental health services.
- Assistance in obtaining and maintaining basic living needs and skills, such as housing, food, medical care, education, employment and recreation.
- Independent living and family integration skills.

FAMILY FOCUSED SOLUTION BASED SERVICES

Family Focused Solution Based Services (FFSBS) provides family and individual therapy, delivered in the home and community, to children with a diagnosed mental health condition, who are at risk for out of home placement. The service is provided by a team, which consists of a therapist and a case manager who use a wide array of treatment methods that are tailored to the strengths and resources of the individual and family.

Family Focused Solution Based Services includes:

- 24-hour access to services
- Case coordination and skill building related to supporting the child's mental health needs in the home and community.
- Collaborative treatment with involved child welfare or juvenile justice entities to identify any unmet family needs.
