

BLENDED CASE MANAGEMENT



WHAT IS BLENDED CASE MANAGEMENT?

Blended Case Management provides case management services to adults with persistent mental illness and children with serious mental illness, emotional or developmental challenges including Autism.

The goal is to maintain the client in their own community. An assigned case manager works with client and families to access, link, coordinate, and monitor needed services as well as provide support and advocacy.

SERVICES PROVIDED:

Services are provided upon a needs based assessment that addresses the following:

- Assistance in obtaining and maintaining basic living needs and skills, such as housing, food, medical care, education, employment and recreation
- Assistance in accessing appropriate mental health services
- Independent living and family integration skills
- 24-hour crisis on-call service

BLENDED CASE MANAGERS WILL:

- Client and assigned case manager will complete a Strengths Based Assessment and Individualized Serve plan within 30 days after referral to program
- Review of the Assessment and Individualized Serve plan at least every six months
- In person contact with client and/or family at least every fourteen days
- Provide services in the client's home or wherever services are needed
